Section - A

Note: This section will contain ten (10) Very Short Answer Type Questions (one word, one sentence, and definitional type item) having weightage of 20 (twenty) marks. Examinees will have to attempt all questions. Each question will be of 2 (two) marks and maximum word limit will be thirty words.

Note: This section will contain eight (8) Short Answer Type Questions. Examinees will have to answer any four (04) questions. Each question will be of 10 (ten) marks. The weightage of this section will be of forty (40) marks. Examinees have to delimit each answer in maximum 200 words.

- 4) How the rivalry between Shylock and Antonio begin and what were the consequences?
- 5) What message does Pope wishes to give through his poem 'Essay on Man'?

- 7) Discuss symbolism with reference to Blake's 'The Chimney Sweeper'.
- 8) Write character sketch of Anthony.
- 9) Critically analyze the style of Dryder's poetry in reference to 'A song for St. Cecilia's Day'.

Section - C
