Section - A

Note: This section will contain ten (10) Very Short Answer Type Questions (one word, one sentence, and definitional type item) having weightage of 20 (twenty) marks. Examinees will have to attempt all questions. Each question will be of 2 (two) marks and maximum word limit will be of thirty words.

- 1) (i) Who are Crooks and Slim in 'Of Mice and Men'?
- (ii) What is Montresor's family aim in the story 'The Cask of Amontillado'?
- (iii) Write about Bhai Meet Singh in 'Train to Pakistan'.
- (iv) What is the difference between a good novel and a bad novel, according to Henry James?

- (v) What is the message in Winston Churchill's 'Speech' given?
- (vi) Write any four names of novels written by Virginia Woolf.
- (vii) What is the effect of the movies on Bigger in 'Native Son' by Richard Wright?
- (viii) What according to Nehru were the immediate problems facing India?
- (ix) Name two writers who influenced Adrienne Rich the most.
- (x) What was Malcolm's intention of writing his autobiography?

Section - B

Note: This section will contain eight (8) Short Answer Type Questions. Examinees will have to answer any four (4) questions. Each question will be of 10 (ten) marks. The weightage of this section will be of forty (40) marks. Examinees have to delimit each answer in maximum 200 words.

- 2) Why, according to Virginia Woolf, have so many women written under assumed male names?
- 3) Discuss the quote by Chinna Achebe 'It doesn't matter what language you write in, as long as what you write is good'.
- 4) What does A.P.J. Abdul Kalam mean by Human resources?
- 5) Explain - 'The novel must have a conscious moral purpose'. Henry James
- 6) How does Steinbrck depict the relation between man and nature?

- 7) Give a character sketch of Jugga, in 'Train to Pakistan'.
- 8) What does Virginia Woolf mean by androgyny?
- 9) What are the future goals that Nehru sets out for the country?

Section - C

Note: This section will contain four (4) Long Answer Type Questions. Each question will be of twenty (20) marks. Examinees will have to answer any two (2) questions. The weightage of this section will be of forty (40) marks. Examinees have to delimit each answer in maximum 500 words.
