- (iii) Describe the pleasure dome in 'Kubla Khan'
- (iv) What are the main characteristics of a pastoral elegy?
- (v) How do you distinguish between a simile and a metaphor?

- (vi) What does 'Hellenism' refer to?
- (vii) Name at least four Romantic poets.
- (viii) In which poem the image of 'an Abyssinian maid singing on the dulcimer' appear?

### Section - B

**Note:** This section contains 8 short answer type questions. Examinees are supposed to answer any 4 questions. Each question carries 8 marks. The weightage of the section is of 32 marks. Limit of each answer is 200 words.

- 3) Write on the myth of Urania and Adonais in Shelley's Adonais.
- 4) How does Keats represent autumn through personification.
- 5) Comment upon the supernatural element in Coleridge's Christabel.
- 6) What are the salient features of Romantic poetry? Discuss.
- 7) Discuss Wordsworth as a poet of nature.
- 8) What is the moral theme in Coleridge's Ancient Mariner.
- 9) What is the significance of the Albatross in the Ancient Mariner.

**Section - C****2 × 16 = 32**

(Long Answer Questions)

**Note:** This section contains 4 long answer type questions. Each question carries sixteen marks. Examinees are supposed to answer any two questions. The weightage of this section comes to 32 marks. The limit of each answer is 500 words.
