- (iii) What is the full name of W. M. Thackeray?
- (iv) Who wrote 'Wuthering Heights';?
- (v) Who is Amelia Sedley?
- (vi) Which novel deals with suspense and mystery of buried treasures?

- (vii) Name the prescribed essay of Carlyle which deals with heroic qualities of Dante and Shakespeare.
- (viii) Who wrote 'The Studies in the History of The Renaissance'?

Section - B **$4 \times 8 = 32$**

Note: Section 'B' will contain 8 (eight) Short Answer Type Questions. Examinees will have to answer any 4 (Four) questions. Each question will be of 8 (eight) marks and maximum word limit for each answer is 200 words. Maximum marks of this section will be 32 marks.

- 3) What according to Pater is the function of a critic?
- 4) Discuss Carlyle's vies on Dante as a Poet Hero.
- 5) Write a character sketch of Egdon Heath.
- 6) Write a short summary of 'The Windhorses'.
- 7) Critically appreciate the poem 'Sohrab and Rustam'.
- 8) Discuss the character of Amelia Sedley.
- 9) Discuss 'Treasure Island' as an adventure novel.

Section - C **$2 \times 16 = 32$**

Note: Section 'C' will contain 4 (four) Long Answer Type Questions and each question will have an internal choice. Examinees will have to answer any two questions. Each question will be of 16 (sixteen) marks and maximum word limit for each answer is 500 words. Maximum marks of this section will be 32 marks.
