The primary colours are red, yellow, and blue. They are the colours that can be mixed together to make different colours. Mixing two primary colours makes a secondary color. The secondary colors are orange, green, and violet (purple). Orange is made by mixing yellow and red. Green is made by mixing yellow and blue. Violet is made by mixing red and blue.

Intermediate colours can be made by mixing a primary and a secondary colour together. Some intermediate colours are blue violet and red orange. Black, white, and grey are special colours. They are called neutral colours, colours have been organized into a colour wheel. It shows the three primary colours, the three secondary colours, and the six intermediate colours. Artists use the colour wheel. It helps them know which colours they want to use together.
