Section - A**10 × 2 = 20**

(Very Short Answer Questions)

Note: This section contains ten (10) very short answer type questions (one word, one sentence, and definition type item) having weightage of twenty (20) marks. Examinees have to attempt all questions. Each question will be of two (02) marks and maximum word limit will be thirty words.

- 1) (i) In which year Francis Bacon was born?
- (ii) Who wrote 'Meditations in Westminster Abby'?
- (iii) Who is Mr. Bumble in 'Oliver Twist'?
- (iv) What was beggar girl's request to Rosemary in the story 'A Cup of Tea'?
- (v) Who is Satish in 'The Castway'?
- (vi) Write the author of 'The Portrait of a Lady'.

- (vii) Who slapped the Talkative man in the story 'Engine Trouble'?
- (viii) How old was Jim in the story 'The Gift of the Magi'?
- (ix) Who was Nathu in 'The Boy Who Broke The Bank'?
- (x) Who is the author of 'My Struggle for an Education'?

Section - B**4 × 10 = 40**

(Short Answer Questions)

Note: This section will contain eight short answer type questions. Examinees will have to answer any four (04) questions. Each question will be of ten (10) marks. The weightage of this section will be of forty (40) marks. Examinees have to delimit each answer in maximum 200 words.

- 2) Discuss the main qualities of Bacon's style.
- 3) How does 'a little knowledge spoil our personality' according to William Hazlitt?
- 4) Give a brief description of the members of the spectator club as given by Richard Steele in his essay.
- 5) Draw a character sketch of Fagin in the novel 'Oliver Twist'.
- 6) Describe the character of Rosemary in the story 'A Cup of Tea'.
- 7) Write a brief summary of 'The Portrait of a Lady'.
- 8) What do you know about the word 'Diaspora'? Write about Indian Diaspora.
- 9) Write a note on Addison's views about the inscriptions on the tomb-stones in the Westminster Abbey.

Section - C**2 × 20 = 40**

(Long Answer Questions)

Note: This section will contain four long answer type questions. Each question will be of twenty (20) marks. Examinees will have to answer any two questions. The weightage of this section will be of forty(40) marks. They have to delimit each answer in maximum 500 words.

- 12) Write a critical appreciation of the story 'The gift of the Magi'.
