**Section - A****10 × 2 = 20**

(Very Short Answer Questions)

**Note:** This section will contain ten (10) very short answer type questions (one word, one sentence and definitional type item) having weightage of 20 (twenty) marks. Examinees will have to attempt all questions. Each question will be of 2 (two) marks and maximum word limit will be thirty words.

- 1) (i) Which figure of speech has been used in “Ten thousand saw I at a glance”?
- (ii) What does Ozymandias refer to?
- (iii) Who is Fra Pandolf in “My Last Duchess”?
- (iv) What figure of speech is in “I wandered lonely as a cloud”?

- (v) How does Frost correspond to the Poet's mood in 'Frost at Midnight'?
- (vi) Which poem by Coleridge is confessional and is about failure?
- (vii) Why does poet prefer night to day in 'To the Night'?
- (viii) Who wrote curtail sonnets?
- (ix) Who is Algernon's best friend?
- (x) What according to Hopkins, is our duty?

### Section - B

**4 × 10 = 40**

(Short Answer Questions)

**Note:** This section will contain eight (8) short answer type questions. Each question will be of ten (10) marks. The weightage of this section will be of forty (40) marks. Examinees will have to attempt any four (4) questions. Examinees have to delimit each answer in maximum 200 words.

- 2) Why does Duke draw the attention of the listener to the bronze sculpture of Naptune taming a horse?
- 3) Comment on the significance of the word "last" in "My Last Duchess".
- 4) Is "La Belle Dame Sans Merci" a poem about writer's block? If so, how?
- 5) How is Jack related to Lady Bracknell?
- 6) How does Goldsmith describe the class divide in India in 'The Deserted Village'? Elaborate.

- 7) Explain the line with reference and context “Wrap thy form in a mantle gray, star inwrought”
- 8) Why does Wordsworth think that the girl’s song will have no ending?
- 9) What is the main idea of the poem, ‘To Night’ by P. B. Shelley?

**Section - C****2 × 20 = 40**

(Long Answer Questions)

**Note:** This section will contain four (4) long answer type questions. Each question will be of twenty (20) marks. Examinees will have to answer any two (2) questions. The weightage of this section will be of forty (40) marks. Examinees have to delimit each answer in maximum 500 words.

- 10) Compare Browning and Tennyson as poets.
- 11) Write an essay on the elements of nostalgia in “The Deserted Village”.
- 12) Write a critical appreciation of Hopkin’s poem, “God’s Grandeur”.
- 13) Write a note on Goldsmith and his contemporary drama and fiction.
