- 4) What are the chief attributes of Indian culture, according to A. P. J. Abdul Kalam?

- 6) Draw a character sketch of Fortunato in the story 'The Cask of Amontillado'
- 7) Describe the social life of Mano Majra village in 'Train To Pakistan'.

- 8) Where was Winston Churchill imprisoned and how did he escape?
- 9) Why is it ironic that Mr. Dalton gives money to charity, in 'Native Son'?
