- 1) (i) Who can be called the first English novelist?
  - (ii) Who was the first critic to use the term metaphysical?
  - (iii) What does the poem 'The Echoing Green' celebrate?
  - (iv) How does the poet describe the clouds in 'Ode to Evening'?
  - (v) On what does poetry exercise 'Self Control'? (Progress of Poesy)

- (vi) What does 'Matrimonial Whoredom' refer to in 'Moll Flanders'?
- (vii) Name the uncle to Tristram and brother of Walter in the novel 'Tristram Shandy'.
- (viii) How did Baron feel after cutting the lock in 'The Rape of the Lock'?

#### Section - B

(Short Answer Questions)

- Note: This section contains 8 (eight) short answer type questions. Answer any 4 (four) questions. Each question carries 8 (eight) marks. The weightage of this section is 32 (thirty two) marks. Delimit each answer in maximum 200 words.
- 2) Discuss Satan as the hero of Paradise Lost Book I, especially on the basis of his speeches made to Bedzebub.
- 3) Critically analyse the poem 'To Daffodils' by Robert Herrick.
- 4) Discuss the allegorical significance of the spider and bee episode in 'The Battle of the Books'.
- 5) Discuss 'The Rape of the Lock' as a satire on society.
- 6) Fielding tries to give a broad moral perspective in Tom Jones. Discuss.
- 7) Write a note on any three pen portraits in 'Absalom and Achitophel'.
- 8) Describe the character of Lady Teazle in 'The School for Scandal'.
- 9) Discuss the conflict between city and country values with reference to 'She stoops to conquer'.

#### Section - C

(Long Answer Questions)

- Note: This section contains 4 (four) long answer type questions. Each question carries 16 (sixteen) marks. Answer any 2 (two) questions. The weightage of this section is 32 (thirty two) marks. Delimit each answer in maximum 500 words.

- 11) Discuss Thomas Gray as a Transitional poet with reference to the poems you have read.
- 12) Write a critical appreciation of 'Ode to Evening' or 'Ode to Simplicity'.
