(vii) What do you understand by 'Hellenism'?

(viii) What is Romanticism?

Section - B

(Short Answer Questions)

Note: This section will contain eight (8) short answer type questions. Examinees will have to answer any four (4) questions. Each question will be of eight (8) marks. The weightage of this section will be of thirty two (32) marks. Examinees have to delimit each answer in maximum 200 words.

- 2) Write a note on the main idea of the poem 'The Rime of the Ancient Mariner'.
- 3) Discuss wordsworth as a poet of nature.
- 4) What is 'Romantic Revival'?
- 5) Comment on the medieval character of Coleridge's poetry.
- 6) Comment on the themes of horror and suspense in 'Christabel'.
- 7) How does Keats personify 'autumn'?
- 8) Comment on the myth of Urania and Adonais in the poem 'Adonais'
- 9) 'The vision of Judgement' is a satire. Discuss.

Section - C**2 × 16 = 32**

(Long Answer Questions)

Note: This section contains four (4) long answer type questions. Each question will be of sixteen (16) marks. Examinees will have to answer any two (2) questions. The weightage of this section will be of thirty two (32) marks. They have to delimit each answer in maximum 500 words.
