- (viii) What is the "Small good thing" referred to in the title?

- 7) What is the main idea of "The American Scholar" by R.W. Emerson.
- Is Raymond Carver's "A small good thing" a pessimistic or optimistic story? Discuss.
- 9) Who is Catherine Barkley in "A farewell to Arms"?
