- (vii) Comment on Browning's diction.
- (viii) Why does the sight of 'happy autumn fields' evoke sadness in Tennyson's heart ?
2. "Wordsworth was truly a romantic poet." Explain.
3. Discuss 'Frost at Midnight' as an autobiographical poem.
4. Give an account of Byron's view of liberty and freedom as revealed in his poem.
5. Write critical appreciation of 'Ozmandias'.
6. Elucidate the poem 'Hymn to the Spirit of Nature' as a remarkable example of Shelley's lyrical richness.
7. 'Pied Beauty' is Hopkins tribute to God as he believes 'Glory to God for Dappled Things'.
8. Comment on the style of 'The Last Duchess'.
9. Discuss Tennyson's poem 'Tears, Idle Tears' as a realistic and emotional poem.
